Ribbon Cutting Ceremony Scheduled for tomorrow

Piti, Guam, November 23, 2009: The Port Authority of Guam will hold a ribbon-cutting ceremony tomorrow at 10 a.m. dockside to celebrate the conclusion of the wharf upgrades and gantry crane rail replacement projects.

Black Construction conducted the work on the \$4 million project which began in March. The wharf upgrades are the first in the past 18 years and this also is the first time the rail system, which is more than 30 years old, has been replaced.

The ceremony begins at 10 a.m. dockside and will include a keynote address by Governor Felix P. Camacho.
