Sea Princess Cruise Ship to arrive tomorrow

Nearly 3,000 passengers and crew will arrive for one-day port call on Guam

Piti, Guam, April 4, 2012: The M/V Sea Princess will sail into Guam's harbor tomorrow morning bringing 2,739 passenger and crew to the island for a one-day visit.

The cruise vessel will arrive dockside at 8am Thursday morning and will depart at 5pm the same day. The ship has 1,892 passengers and 847 crew onboard. Most of the passengers are from Australia and the U.S. mainland. According to the ship's agent, Marianas Steamship Agencies, Inc., the cruise ship is sailing to Guam from Japan and will depart Guam for Papua New Guinea and then return to Brisbane, Australia on April 13th. The Sea Princess voyage began on March 4th in Australia and has made stops at many locations including Bali, Malaysia, China and Korea.

The Sea Princess will be met upon arrival by cultural dancers and entertainers. This is the first port call to Guam by the Sea Princess, which is based out of Santa Clarita, California and is a subsidiary of Carnival Corp.
