II. Intent and Purpose

The Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port or Port Authority of Guam (PAG), hereinafter referred to as PAG, an autonomous agency is inviting firms to participate in the Invitation for Bid (IFB) No.: IFB-PAG-CIP-021-006 Repair of Mobil Golf Fuel Pier.

III. Description:

The Mobil Golf Fuel Pier is located on the west side of Cabras, Piti - after the Fuel Storage Tanks and adjacent the Cementon Bulk Storage. The project includes the repair of the corroded piles supporting the main pier, and access ramp (trestle and concrete driveway). Repairs will make the structure stable when induced by lateral loads such as wind and seismic. Corroded piles will be replaced by new piles within -4.0ft from the mean low water level. Steel pipe piles shall be filled with high strength concrete and additional threaded bars for tension forces inside the core of the pile.

Electrical work shall include replacement of electrical equipment as needed which are not feasible to repair; including Electrical panel, which is aged and for which replacement parts are difficult to obtain, lighting controls and Electrical boxes exhibiting severe corrosion. Replacement of exterior light poles and fixtures which are severely corroded and associated wiring with new wiring.

All systems must meet the federal/local regulations and IBC 2009 requirements. For more information regarding all requirements, please see IFB Scope of Work.
