Port E-Advisory No. 14

Please be advised that late this afternoon I was notified that a Port Authority of Guam employee has tested positive for COVID-19. The individual was not one of the 59 Port employees who were identified last week as being potentially exposed to COVID-19 at a location outside of the Port. The individual who tested positive today had limited exposure at the Port as the employee began to isolate at home at the onset of symptoms.

As for the 59 employees exposed to a positive Covid-19 case outside of the Port, please be advised that we are still coordinating with the Department of Public Health and Social Services on testing availability for those who were in direct contact.

Once again, it is with great importance that we continue to be diligent in practicing the following to protect ourselves, our loved ones and each other.

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Take a bath as soon as you come back from work/office.
- Distance yourself at least six-feet from someone else (even while at home).
- Frequently clean and sanitize all surfaces.

Additionally, we also would like to remind you that if you have been in contact with a co-worker, family or friend, who has been informed by Public Health that they have been exposed to someone who confirmed positive for COVID-19, please observe the following Public Health guidelines:

- Notify your supervisor within two (2) hours of when Public Health informed you that you
 may have been exposed to a person who has tested positive for COVID-19.

 <u>Do NOT</u> take it upon yourself to self-quarantine, or to report to your regular duty station,
 unless you have been seen and cleared by the nurse at the Port Clinic;
- 2. However, if you are symptomatic (experiencing the COVID-19 symptoms), you are to immediately self-quarantine, call your physician, then notify your supervisor. All of this should also happen within two hours of when you are feeling symptomatic. You are required to provide a doctor's note if you are absent for three consecutive days or more; and
- 3. If you are **asymptomatic** (experiencing no COVID-19 symptoms), and concerned that you may have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 (confirmed or rumored) please inform your supervisor immediately. You will still be required to come to work, and must continue to observe all extraordinary precautions, including checking-in daily with the Port Clinic.
