Pompeo criticizes leaks of fired **IG's probes**

WASHINGTON - Secretary of State Mike Pompeo decried leaks to the media about internal investigations into his office on Wednesday, calling allegations that the department's inspector general was fired in retaliation for his inquiries "patently

Pompeo, holding his first news conference since President Donald Trump terminated the department's ethics watchdog, Steve Linick, said the president did so at his recom-mendation, adding that he "frankly should have done it some time ago." But the nation's top diplomat bristled at more specific questions regarding the reason for Linick's firing. Linick had been conducting two

investigations that were potentially damaging to Pompeo. One centered on the Trump administration's deci-sion to expedite arms sales to Saudi Arabia, according to New York Rep. Eliot Engel, athe Democratic chair-man of the House Foreign Affairs Committee.

The other involved questions over hether one of Pompeo's aides, a staffer who had worked for him during his time as a Kansas congressman ad conducted personal business on State Department time.

Pompeo conflated the two investigations as he bitterly rejected the idea that the inspector general's firing was in retallation for the investigations, which were ongoing at the time of Linick's ouster.

Trump threatens to freeze aid for Michigan, Nevada

WASHINGTON - President Donald Trump on Wednesday threatened funding for Michigan amid a global health pandemic if state officials move ahead with plans to send absentee

ballot applications to every state voter.
Michigan Secretary of State Jocelyn Benson on Tuesday morning said, in a story first reported in the Detroit Free Press, she and local clerks will send absentee ballot applications to all of the state's 7.7 million voters so they can, if they choose to do so, take part in the Aug. 4 and Nov. 3 elections without

going to polling places.

Doing so, she said, would allow voters to avoid the potential threat posed by the spread of COVID-19.

But Trump, who has railed against widespread voting by mail, posted on Twitter about 7:50 a.m. a suggestion that if she did so, he would move to

block funding for Michigan.

In his first post, it was unclear the president understood what he was talking about, as he suggested Michigan was in the process of sending absence ballots themselves – not
